

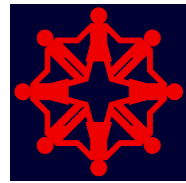

Although the standards at the end of KS2 this year, did not meet our expectations, we are very proud of the effort and resilience this Year 6 cohort has shown. Since 2016, the children have been getting to grips with the curriculum standards which has proved challenging. However, they have demonstrated determination to try and reach the expected standard and we commend the children and staff for that.
