

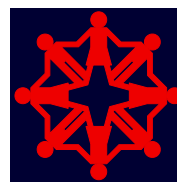

Dear Parent/Carers

You will have seen the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday 22nd February, 2021 that all schools in England will be reopening on Monday 8th March. We are delighted that our children at All Saints' Primary will be able to come back as we know how important the return to school will be for their learning and for their mental health and wellbeing. Nearly a year since the first national lockdown, you can be assured that the return to school for your child/children is a smooth and happy one, regardless of any gaps in their learning or other needs that may have emerged during this lockdown. We have a well-established set of procedures to ensure appropriate hygiene and social distancing and will keep all risks to an absolute minimum.

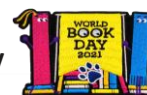
