Whales Class - Forest School

Year 5 have enjoyed a morning of forest school to consolidate their geography topic. They analysed the different types of trees and their characteristics and collected samples of insects in their natural habitat such as woodlice, slugs and earthworms. Whales Class also learnt about survival skills such as how to construct shelter using minimal materials and how to build and maintain a fire safely.
