

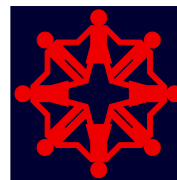

Letters/Forms

You will receive many forms that require your permission such as Local Community Trip, Mobile Phone Contract, Walking home etc. Please complete all letters and return them to the school office as soon as possible



Cool Milk

All children under the age of 5 will receive milk and fruit.

If your child is over 5 years old and you would like them to receive milk, please complete a Cool Milk Application form and we will then provide your child with milk daily.

School Uniforms & PE Kits

Please ensure your child attends school every day in full school uniform.

School Uniform – Please ensure all of your child's school clothing is labelled with their name – especially jumpers and coats.

Your child will also need to bring their PE Kits on their allocated PE days or leave them at school on their peg until half term.



Free School Meals

If you believe you are entitled to Free School Meals, you will need to complete a FSM funding form and return it to the school office immediately.

If your child is entitled to FSM, they will be able to have a school meal free of charge, Milk and 1 afterschool activity for free.

This year, following the Mayor of London's initiative, all Primary school pupils will receive a free school meal, but parents must continue to complete an eligibility form.
