

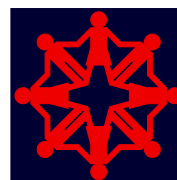

### Message from the Police

'Elianne Andam's death has had a profound impact on everyone who lives in our borough and people are devastated.

'As the people in support each other and try and come terms with what has happened, I want to reassure everyone that the investigation team diligently continues its work, as does our support for her family at this most difficult of times.

'In order to support justice for Elianne, I'd like to ask people to refrain from sharing online any information, rumours, or material which could affect the court proceedings. I'd ask you to consider Elianne's family who could be reading these posts and the impact this could have on them at this already difficult time.

'As we know, a 17-year-old has been remanded in custody in connection with the case and this means that legal proceedings are active. It is extremely important not to prejudice these proceedings.


'Any information which could be useful to the investigation should only be shared with our detectives by calling police on 101 or anonymously via @Crimestoppers and any footage to be sent into the police using the link [Public Portal \(mipp.police.uk\)](https://mipp.police.uk)
