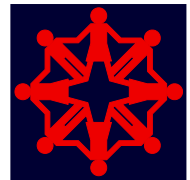

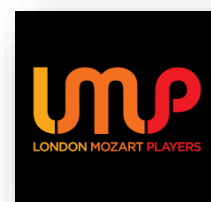
Communications Team
