

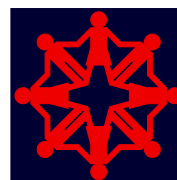

## YR2 Hummingbirds Class - Science



Hummingbird Class have been learning about how Arctic animals have adapted to suit their natural habitat. We explored how 'blubber' in arctic animals helps to keep them warm in freezing conditions. Children used lard on their gloved hands to represent this special layer of fat and placed their hands on ice, representing the Arctic. We compared it to a gloved hand without lard. We then rated how cold it felt on a scale of 0-10. We immediately observed that our hands felt warmer with the layer of lard around them.

## Punctuality

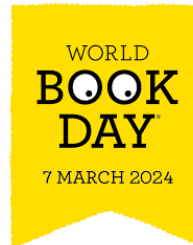
**Be on time and arrive before 9!** We want all pupils to be part of morning worship and not miss out on learning!

### Introducing our New MHST Practitioner



Jasmine is an Emotional Wellbeing Practitioner, and will be based at All Saints on Wednesday mornings. She has experience of working with children and families in primary and secondary schools, and will be supporting us to continue promoting emotional wellbeing at All Saints.

Jasmine will be using evidence based, low intensity intervention for children who present with anxiety, low mood and behaviour difficulties. She will work with parents and carers to achieve their child's goals and support parents with strategies to practice with their child. Jasmine will be holding some weekly

workshops which will focus on low mood, anxieties, routines and transactions, amongst other things. Jasmine is looking forward to being part of the All Saints community.

Workshops:

**13<sup>th</sup> March** – Helping your child understand/manage big emotions (low mood)

**20<sup>th</sup> March** – Helping your child with fears and worries

**27<sup>th</sup> March** – Dealing with difficult behaviours
