

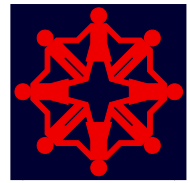

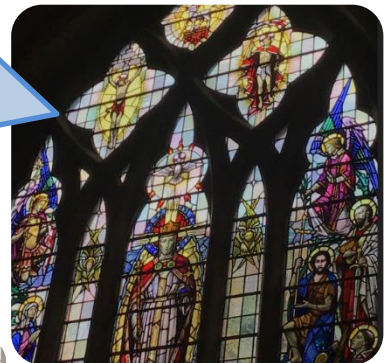
Eliel in YR6 has beautifully expressed what she believes a courageous advocate is:

'Courageous advocates can come from any background or country, like Nelson Mandela, who fought for justice and a culture of freedom. Many people think you need to be famous to be a courageous advocate but I know that if you stand up for what you believe in, that makes YOU one. For example, of us are courageous advocates because we donated £512 to the Lunchbowl network, which is a small charity for children in schools in Kibera, Kenya, to have food to eat at lunchtime in school. I believe that no child or baby or even adult should suffer just to eat a normal meal even if it is at work or school or at home.'

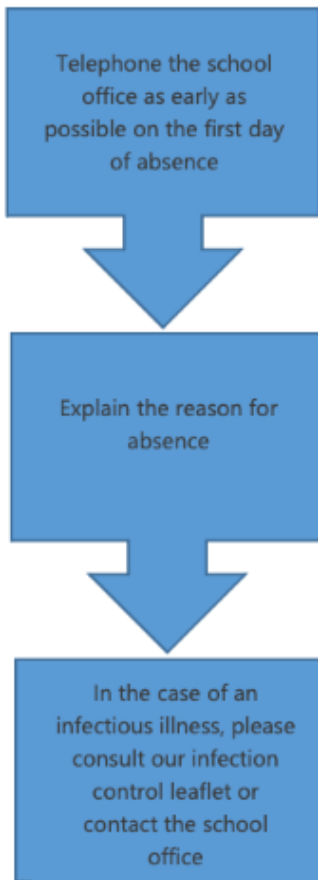
Attendance

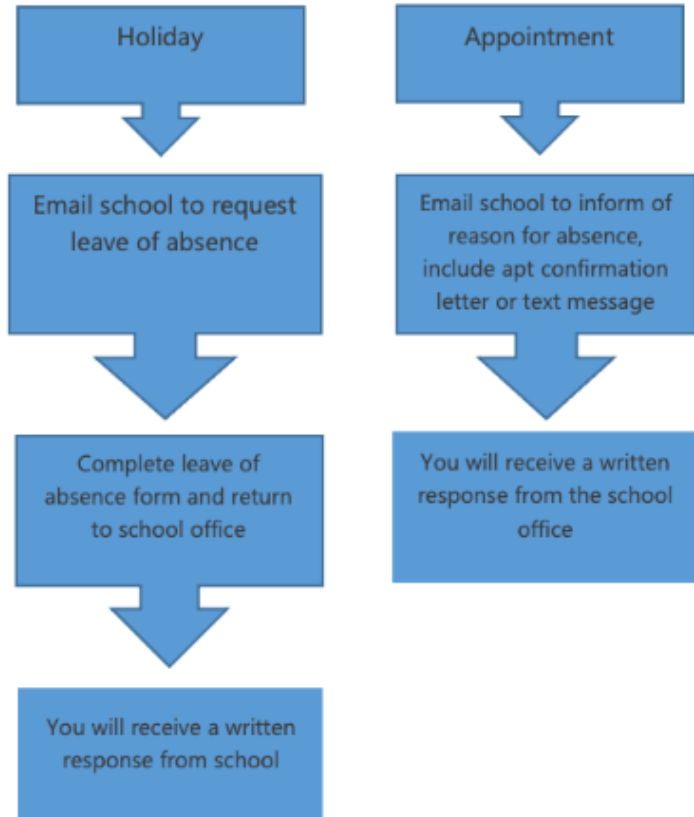
