Easter Activity

This Easter, the children have been asked to research a courageous advocate and present their findings in:

- A poster
- A PowerPoint
- A Video
- Art work
- Write a speech about them
- Any other creative way you want to present your research

What is a courageous advocate?

A courageous advocate is someone who supports champions and speaks up for a cause that is important and meaningful to them. Courage is needed to persevere and stand up for something or someone you believe in, to make a difference.

Year 2 Geography and Science

Year 2 have been learning about the climate in the Arctic and discussed climate change. They investigated how the melting ice-caps can affect sea levels by setting up a comparative experiment. They put blocks of ice in two trays and placed one near a radiator to represent global warming. We placed the other outside, where it is colder, to compare. We saw that the ice had melted in tray near the radiator and measured the amount of water using a ruler. There was almost 1 centimetre of water covering the rocks that represented land! We discovered that higher temperatures cause ice to melt and sea levels to rise and that polar bears are at risk of drowning because of this.



The block of ice represents the sea ice in the Arctic.



The ice melted when there was a higher temperature and we measured almost 1cm of water in the tray!

We placed a tray with ice outside because it was cooler than the temperature inside the classroom.



Look at the difference between the two trays! The higher the temperatures, the more ice is melted.



Did you know oceanographers measure sea levels?



We can remember to do little things to help with climate change.



Polar bears will find it difficult to survive in the Arctic because they will drown.



Science Week at All Saints!

The children gathered in the hall to celebrate science this week. They were challenged to quizzes about living things and their habitats, and the solar system, they completed competitive tasks like Darwin's Finches experiment, they identified bones in the human skeleton and sorted objects according to the materials they are made of under time pressure. They recalled so much of their knowledge this year! Reception class also shared their discovery of objects that float or sink! Children's scientific skills were also showcased in front of the whole school with live demonstrations of experiments and investigations shared for everyone to watch! We have brilliant scientists here at All Saints School! Well done!
