The Earth - seasonal changes (Year 1) We are active learners, taking part in demonstrations and discussion.




Forest School - woodland blome (Year 3) We use our Forest School area to perform fieldwork.




We can all access these resources: atlases, wall map, globe.




The Earth - longitude, latitude, night, day (Year 5) We visit renowned locations in London to support our learning.
