

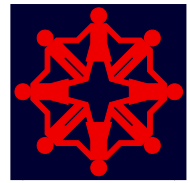

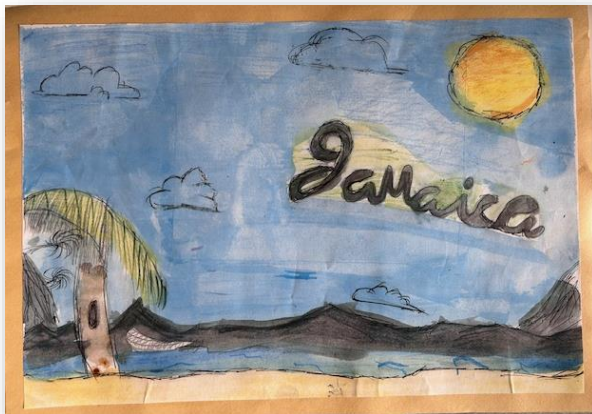

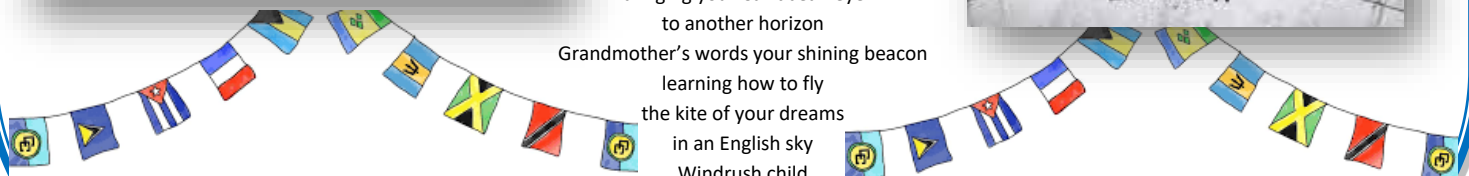
Year 6 performed the poem 'Windrush Child' from Under the Moon & Over the Sea by John Agard

As always, Pandas Class sang beautifully to uplift everyone.


