

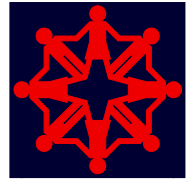

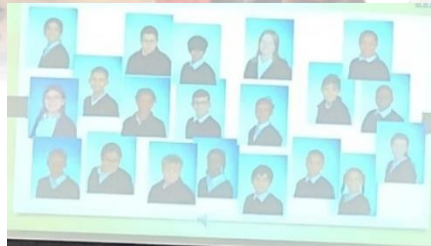

Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.


If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.

We are also using the Studybugs app for reporting absences.

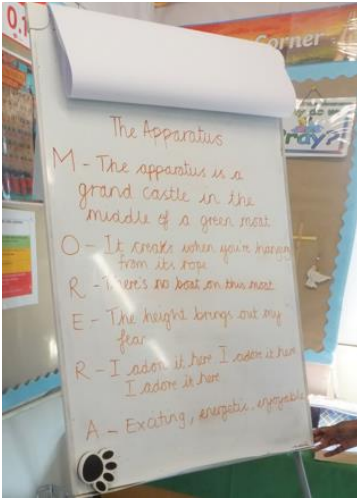

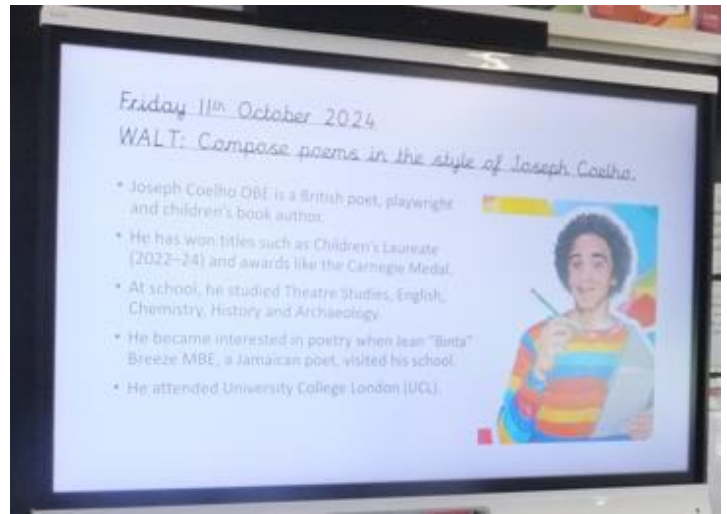
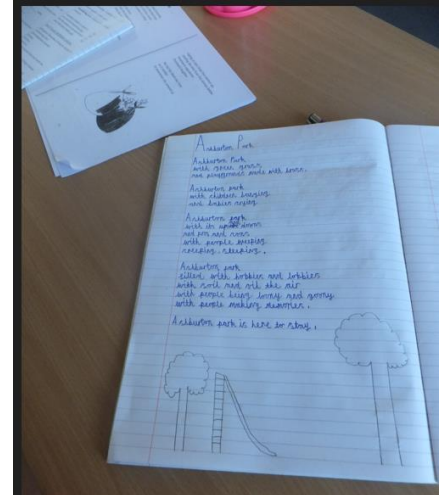
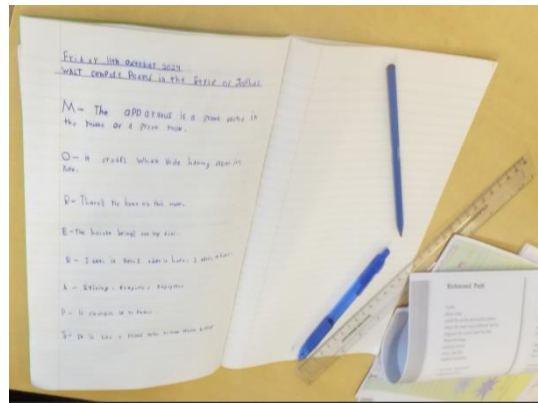


# Diversity Day in Year 6
