

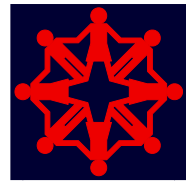

Year 3 Science



As part of their Science topic, Year 3 have been researching the growth of plants. They have observed and described the stages of the life cycle of a flowering plant. Year 5 Music



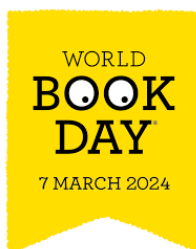
