

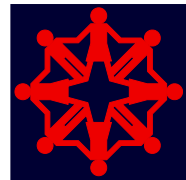

## Dolphin Class Worship

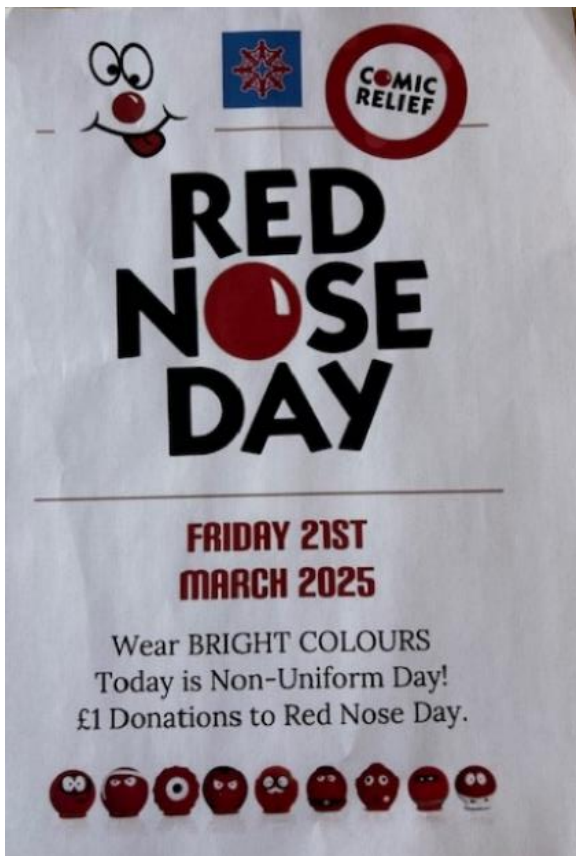

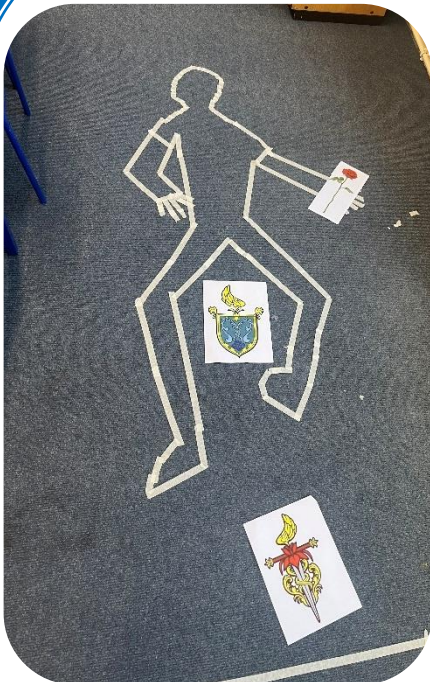

## The Sensory Room

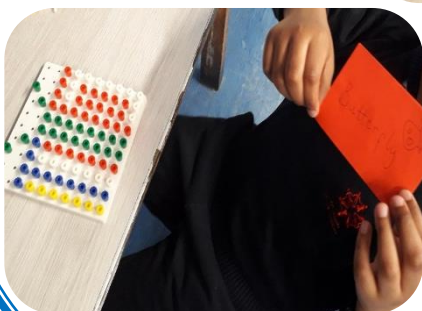
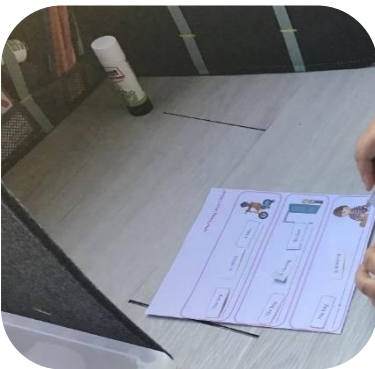

### Introducing our MHST Practitioner



Hi, my name is Anita, and I am the Children's Wellbeing Practitioner (CWP) working in schools as a member of The Mental Health Support Team (MHST). Schools provide an important role in supporting the wellbeing of children and young people at a time when there are lots of physical emotional and social changes. Within my role I provide an additional source of support for young people and their families.

I work in All Saints Primary School on Thursday mornings, offering a variety of support. I deliver workshops for the children around friendships and transitions as well as support with emotional regulation in small groups. For parents, I provide a confidential and non-judgemental space for 1:1 sessions, giving them strategies to help them support their children with behavioural difficulties and anxiety. Finally, I support staff in keeping wellbeing and emotional health at the heart of school life. Requests for support can be made through your school's wellbeing lead. I am looking forward to getting to know and working with the families at All Saints.
