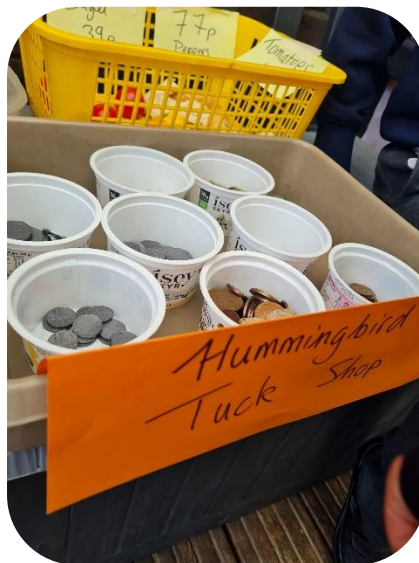
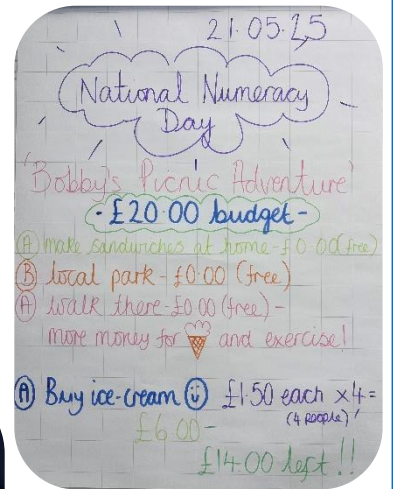
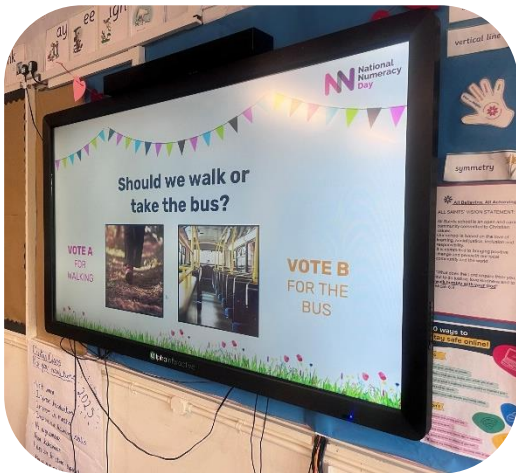
Thank you to all the parents and carers that came along to support the pupils, they really did do a wonderful job!

National Numeracy Day

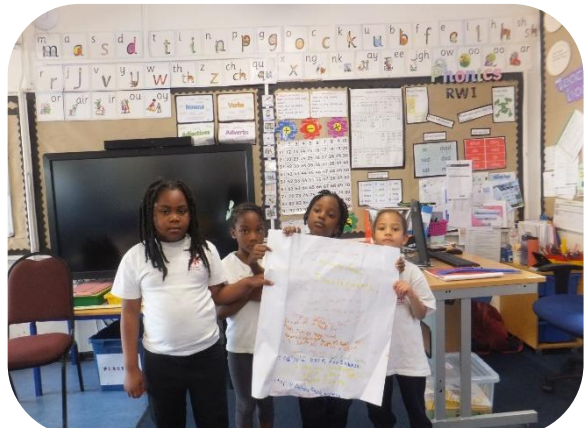
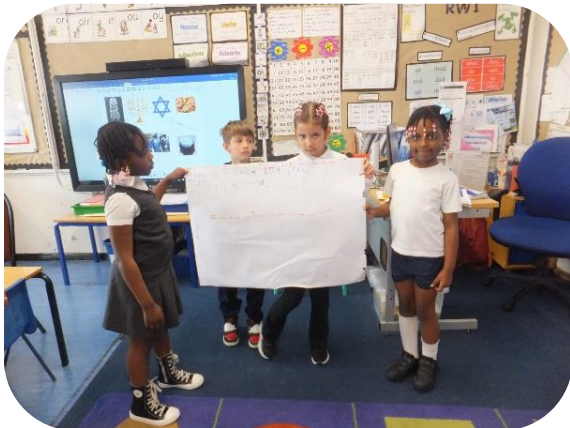
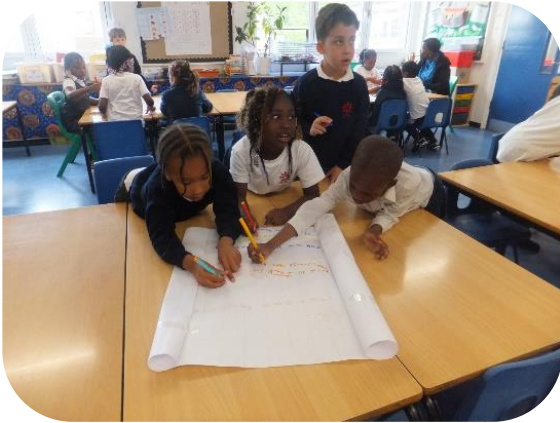

Reporting Absences

What YOU must do:

Try to telephone the school before 8.30am each day of your child's absence or email.

Report your child's absence via the Studybugs App.

Tell the school in advance, of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters.

If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway as they often perk up on arrival.

If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

What WE will do:

Check your child's attendance every day.

Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.

Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.

If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.

If you are unsure, please contact a member of staff.

5 days absence is equivalent to 10 sessions and each session is counted as an absence.

So, morning and afternoon registration counts!



A reminder that holidays will not be authorised during term time. You may be at risk of receiving a fine from the Local Authority, which is currently £160 per parent, reducing to £80 per parent if paid within 21 days.

Peaceful Entrance and Exit



In preparation for next half term, we are reminding all our pupils and families to enter and exit the school as quietly and peacefully as possible.

We are representing All Saints School and so we must uphold high standards of behaviour when in public at all times- be it when walking along the road, waiting for a bus or when on the bus/train. A peaceful entrance and exit is also part of our school behaviour expectations and staff will be monitoring this.

We expect our pupils to put mobile phones out of sight and speak quietly to one another without shouting or using inappropriate language as they travel home or to school. Please remember that scooters and bikes are NOT allowed to be ridden in the school walkway as it is dangerous for others walking.

Next year, parents requesting permission for their children to travel to and from school alone will have a new request form to sign which will have the above expectations of behaviour attached as part of the agreement.
