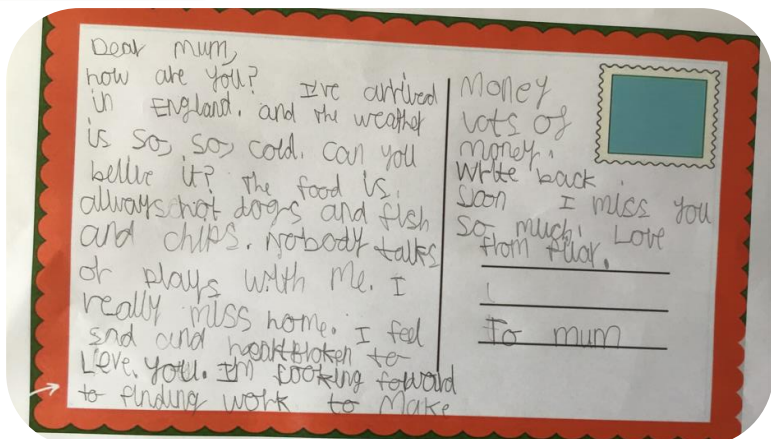
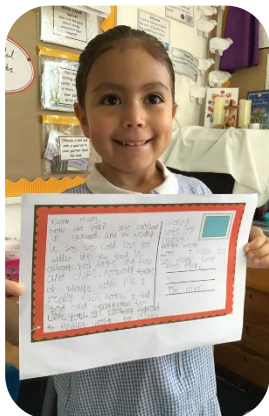
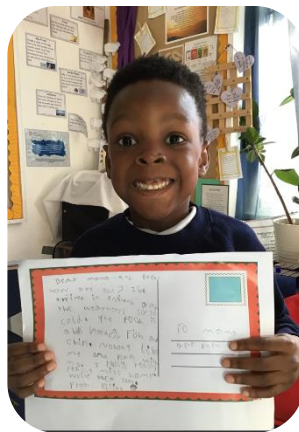
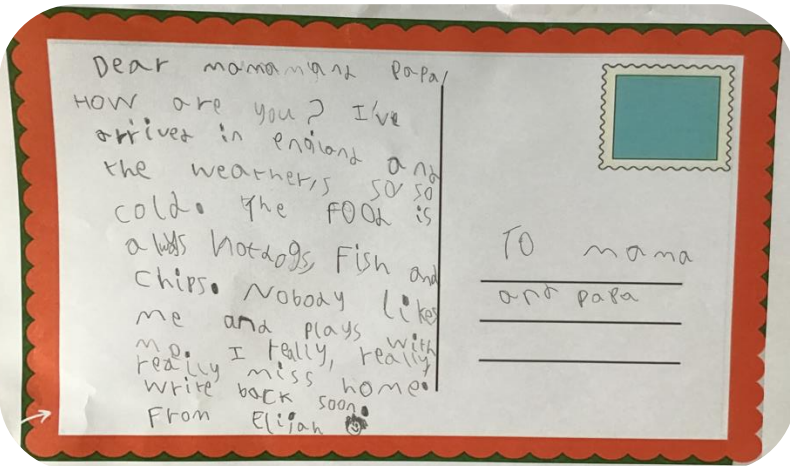
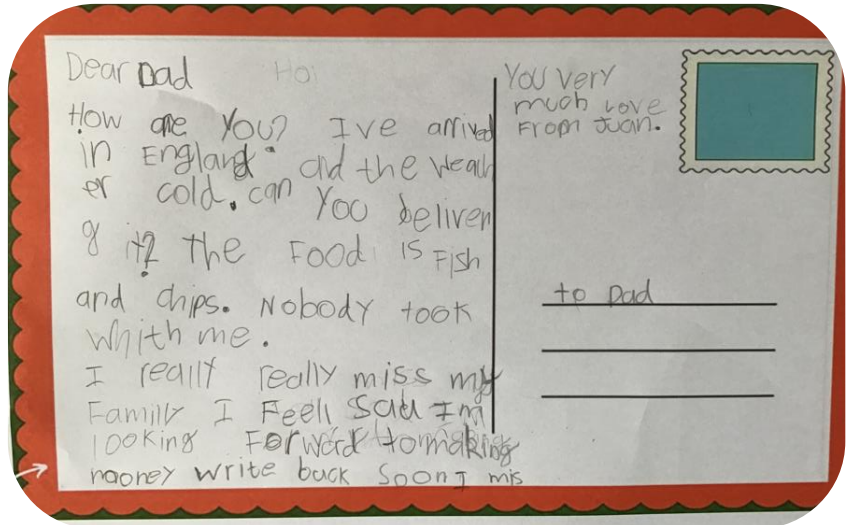
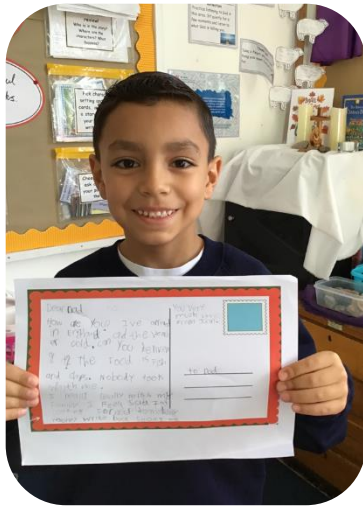
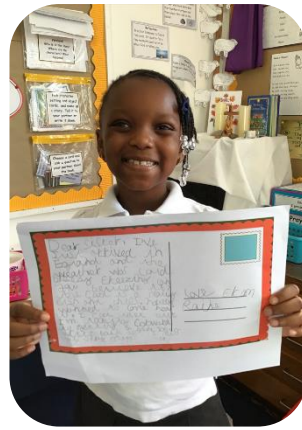
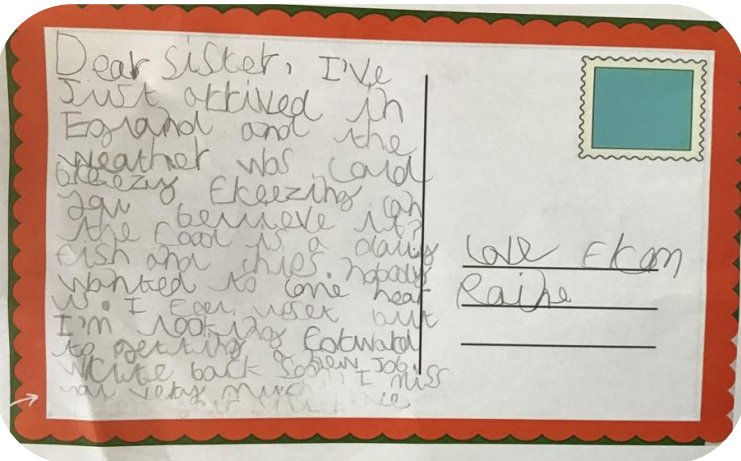
## Year 1 Trip to Capel Manor Farm

### Reporting an Absence

#### What YOU must do:

Try to telephone the school before 8.30am each day of your child's absence or email.

Report your child's absence via the Studybugs App.

Tell the school in advance, of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters.

If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway as they often perk up on arrival.

If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

#### What WE will do:

Check your child's attendance every day.

Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.

Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.

If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.

If you are unsure, please contact a member of staff.

**5 days absence is equivalent to 10 sessions and each session is counted as an absence.**

**So, morning and afternoon registration counts!**

**A reminder that holidays will not be authorised during term time. You may be at risk of receiving a fine from the Local Authority, which is currently £160 per parent, reducing to £80 per parent if paid within 21 days.**
