

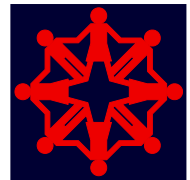

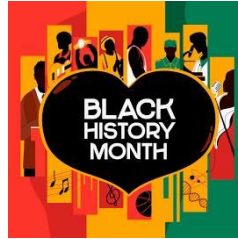

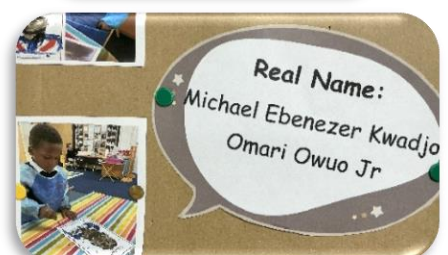

Primary Science Quality Mark

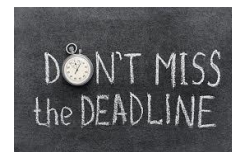
We are extremely proud to announce that the school has been awarded a Primary Science Quality Mark.

What YOU must do:

Try to telephone the school before 8.30am **each day** of your child's absence or email.

If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

What WE will do:

Check your child's attendance every day.

Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.

Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.

If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.

If you are unsure, please contact a member of staff.
