

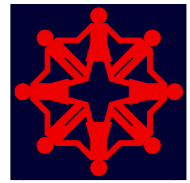

You will have received an email on 26th November for each child containing your booking link/voucher to the Holiday Activities platform. You will be able to select and book the dates you require, this can only be done online.



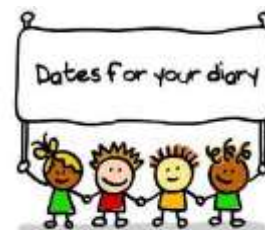
We would like to say a huge thank you to Simply 4 Group, for their generosity in donating 4 scooters to KS1. The pupils are enjoying them!
