

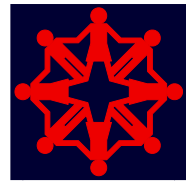

## YR1 Phonics Information Meeting



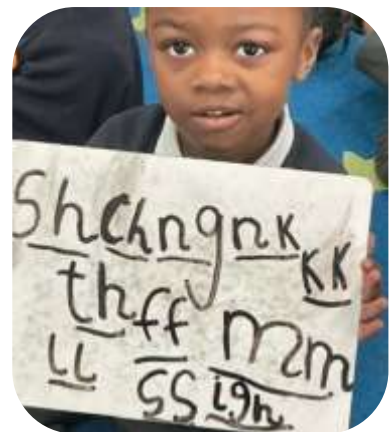
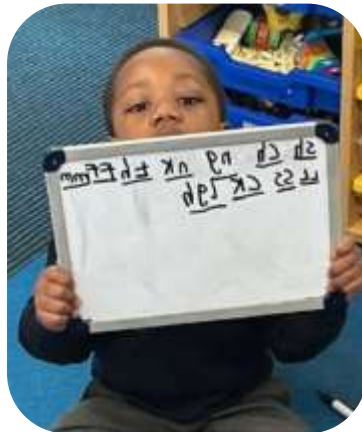
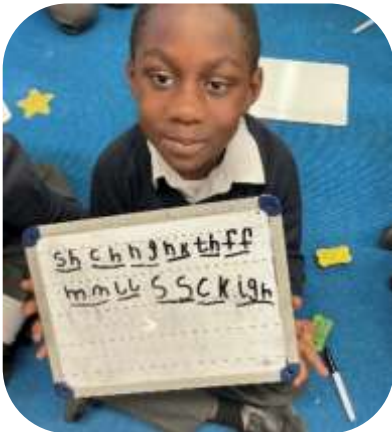

## Eco Warriors



