

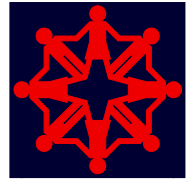

They also paid tribute to their parents and teachers by singing *‘Because You Believed’*, showing their gratitude to the people who encourage, support and believe in them.

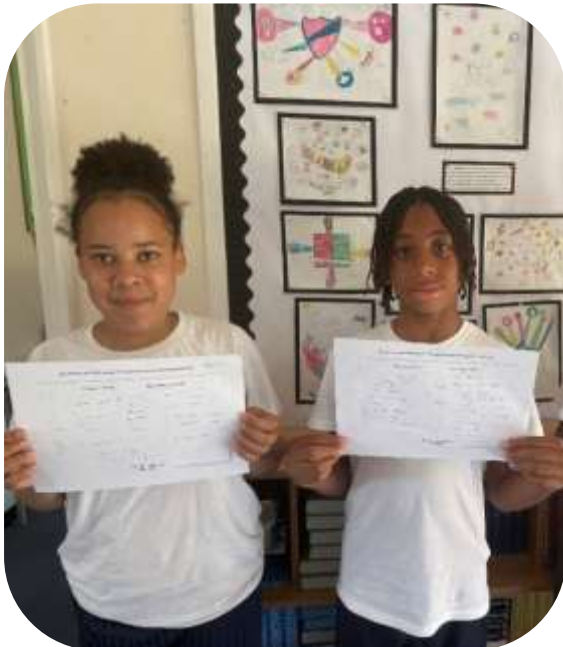
It was a wonderful worship that showed the importance of hope, kindness and believing in ourselves and others.
