

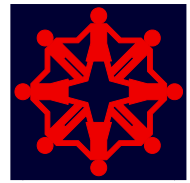

Year 5 Science

Year 5 became rocket engineers as they designed five different model rockets and predicted which would sink the slowest. Look at the designs in the photograph below. Which one do you think would win?



Through their investigation, pupils discovered that rockets with a larger surface area and a more streamlined shape experienced greater water resistance, causing them to fall more slowly to the bottom of the container. The excitement of testing their predictions and seeing science in action made this a memorable and enjoyable learning experience for everyone.



Year 6 Leavers' Service at Southwark Cathedral



Our Year 6 pupils enjoyed a special visit to Southwark Cathedral to mark the end of their primary school journey. The service gave the children an opportunity to reflect, celebrate their achievements and look ahead with excitement to the next stage of their education.

Year 4 Science



Year 4 Cheetah Class conducted an experiment to prove a theory: as the distance from the source of a sound increases, the volume decreases.

They worked collaboratively, using scientific skills to record the volume of sounds in decibels (using a digital decibel metre). They worked superbly well and Ms Escorial is extremely proud of them!
